FOUR LADIES PROMENADE, ONE TIME AROUND, BACK HOME AND SWING, SWING THAT MAN AROUND, JOIN HANDS AND CIRCLE TO THE LEFT AROUND THE RING, ALLEMANDE LEFT THAT CORNER AND WEAVE AROUND THE RING SINGING, I WILL, I WILL FOLLOW THEE, SWING YOUR LADY ROUND AND PROMENADE WITH ME, AND WHEN I HEAR YOUR VOICE LORD NO MATTER HOW I FEEL, I WILL LAY MY BURDENS DOWN, I WILL FOLLOW THEE,

FIGURE:

HEADS (SIDES) PROMENADE HALF WAY AROUND, DOWN THE MIDDLE AND SQUARE THRU 4 HANDS AROUND, GO ALL THE WAY AND DO THE RIGHT AND LEFT THRU, VEER LEFT, FERRIS WHEEL, WALKING TWO BY TWO, SQUARE THRU THREE QUARTERS, CORNER LADY SWING, SWING THAT GIRL AROUND AND PROMENADE THE RING, AND WHEN I HEAR YOUR VOICE LORD NO MATTER HOW I FEEL, I WILL LAY MY BURDEN'S DOWN, I WILL FOLLOW THEE
