OPENER, BREAK, CLOSER: (CIRCLE LEFT)

AS I WAS GOING OVER THE CORK AND KERRY MOUNTAINS
I SAW CAPTAIN FARRELL AND HIS MONEY HE WAS COUNTIN'
MEN STAR RIGHT, ONE TIME AROUND

LEFT ALLEMANDE AND WEAVE THE RING *

MUSHA RING DUM A DO DUM A DA (CLAP CLAP CLAP)
WHACK FOL THE DADDY-O (CLAP CLAP)
SWING YOUR GIRL AND PROMENADE
MUSHA RING DUM A DO DUM A DA (CLAP CLAP CLAP)
WHACK FOL THE DADDY-O (CLAP CLAP)
WHACK FOL THE DADDY-O THERE'S WHISKEY IN THE JAR

FIGURE:

HEADS (SIDES) PROMENADE HALF WAY AROUND
WALK IN WITH A **RIGHT AND LEFT THRU**, TURN THE GIRL AROUND
FLUTTER WHEEL AND THEN, **SWEEP A QUARTER** MORE, **PASS THRU**
AND A **RIGHT AND LEFT THRU**, TURN'EM 'ROUND MY FRIEND
TOUCH A QUARTER HERE, **SPLIT CIRCULATE GO TWICE**
SWING THE CORNER LADY AND **PROMENADE** TONIGHT
MUSHA RING DUM A DO DUM A DA
WHACK FOL THE DADDY-O WHACK FOL THE DADDY-O
THERE'S WHISKEY IN THE JAR
