HEADS (SIDES) SOUARE THRU 4 HANDS AROUND NOW DO-SA-DO ONE TIME AND GO SWING THRU AND THEN, BOYS RUN RIGHT BEND THE LINE THEN A RIGHT AND LEFT THRU PASS THE OCEAN HERE, RECYCLE YOU KNOW SWING THAT CORNER AND PROMENADE 'EM HOME SOMETIMES I WONDER WHAT I'M A-GONNA DO BUT THERE AIN'T NO CURE FOR THE SUMMERTIME BLUES
