OPENER, CLOSER (CIRCLE LEFT)

MEN STAR RIGHT ONE TIME AROUND

LEFT ALLEMANDE AND WEAVE THE TOWN

I'D TAKE MY PUPPY EVERYWHERE

AND WE WOULD STAY AWAY FROM CROWDS

AND SIGNS THAT SAID NO DOGS (FRIENDS) ALLOWED

FIGURE:

HEADS (SIDES) PROMENADE HALF WAY GO

WALK IN AND **SQUARE THRU FOUR** HANDS YOU KNOW

GO ALL THE WAY, DO YOUR DO-SA-SO

MAKE YOUR WAVE, **SWING THRU** YOU KNOW

BOYS RUN RIGHT, COUPLES CIRCULATE

CHAIN DOWN THE LINE, (KEEP HER) PROMENADE

OH YOU WISH TO COME TRUE (MUSIC PLAYS OUT 16 COUNTS)

BREAK: (SIDES FACE GRAND SQUARE)

IF ONLY I COULD HAVE A FRIEND

TO STICK WITH ME UNTIL THE END

AND WALK ALONG BESIDE THE SEA

AND SHARE A CUP OF TEA WITH ME

FOUR LADIES PROMENADE THE INSIDE AND GO

SWING YOUR MAN, PROMENADE BACK HOME

AND WALK ALONG BESIDE THE SEA

AND SHARE A BIT OF MOON WITH ME
