FIGURE:

HEADS (SIDES) PROMENADE HALF WAY 'ROUND SIDES (HEADS) SQUARE THRU FOUR HANDS 'ROUND, GO ALL THE WAY THEN PASS THRU TRADE BY, SLIDE THRU, RIGHT & LEFT THRU SQUARE THRU THREE QUARTERS, SWING CORNER PROMENADE THE RING NEVER KNOWN IT WHEN IT FELT SO GOOD NEVER KNEW IT WHEN I KNEW I COULD NEVER DONE IT WHEN IT LOOKED SO RIGHT LEAVING LOUSIANA IN THE BROAD DAYLIGHT

BREAK:

FOUR LADIES CHAIN ACROSS, TURN THE LADY THERE LADIES ROLL AWAY CIRCLE LEFT NOW FOUR LADIES ROLL AWAY, CIRCLE LEFT IN THE USUAL WAY LEFT ALLEMANDE AND WEAVE THE RING WIND IN AND OUT AROUND WHEN YOU MEET THAT GIRL TAKE HER BY THE HAND AND PROMENADE.
