FIGURE:

HEADS (SIDES) PROMENADE HALF WAY
WALK IN AND PASS THE OCEAN, EXTEND,
SWING THRU, BOYS RUN RIGHT MY FRIEND
FERRIS WHEEL, RIGHT AND LEFT THRU
HALF SASHAY, U-TURN BACK AND
SWING THAT CORNER PROMENADE
NOBODY HERE CAN WALK IT FOR YOU
YOU'VE GOT TO WALK IT BY YOURSELF

MIDDLE BREAK: SIDES FACE GRAND SQUARE (KEY CHANGE)

THERE'S A ROAD THAT LEADS TO GLORY
THRU A VALLEY FAR AWAY . . .
NOBODY ELSE CAN WALK IT FOR YOU
THEY CAN ONLY POINT THE WAY, (FOUR LADIES PROMENADE)
