BEND THE LINE, AND DO THE **RIGHT AND LEFT THRU**
TWO LADIES GONNA CHAIN (LA LA LA)
KEEP THAT GIRL AND PROMENADE HER
DOWN AT THE LA LA LA LA, LA LA LA LA
DOWN AT THE LAH DE DAH

BREAK: (SIDES FACE, GRAND SQUARE)

WHEN THE STARS COME OUT IT'S THE PLACE TO BE
IF YOU'RE ALL ALONE AND NEEDING COMPANY
IT'S A LOVER'S BAR WHERE THE FUN IS FREE
LEFT ALLEMANDE AND YOU WEAVE (*"SING WITH ME NOW"*)
